- b. Objectives

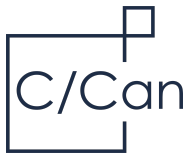
The objectives of the project must be clearly defined and aligned with both the LCWC recommendations and C/Can's identified priorities in the City.

- c. Methods / Intervention

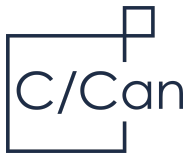
